

MESSAGE FROM THE VICAR

“For surely I know the plans I have for you, says the Lord, plans for your welfare and not for harm, to give you a future with hope. Then when you call upon me and come and pray to me, I will hear you.” (Jeremiah 29:11-12).

The new year begins for an Orthodox Christian with a number of feasts. The day of circumcision of our Lord and the feast of Basil and Gregorios, the great church fathers, fall on New Year day. The feast of Epiphany of Our Lord on January 6, the feast of John the Baptist on January 7 and the feast of St. Stephen, head of the deacons and the first Christian Martyr on January 8.

Among these, Epiphany is the most important and ancient feast after Easter relating to our Lord. It is observed by the Orthodox Church on January 6th. The feast is called “Denhao” in Syriac which means manifestation. It is also known as the Feast of Lights. By the fourth century the feast of Epiphany ranked with Easter and Pentecost as one of the three principal festivals of the Church. Epiphany is a Greek word derived from ‘epi’ (to) and ‘phainein’ (to show forth). This feast included the birth of Christ, His Baptism and the appearance of the Holy Trinity. “And just as He was coming up out of the water, He saw the heavens torn apart and the Spirit descending like a dove on Him. And a voice came from heaven, “You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased” (St. Mark 1: 10,11).

In the east, the Nativity of Christ is celebrated with Epiphany on 6th January. Nativity was introduced from the West, observed on December 25th as Yeldho, but January 6th remained as Epiphany day in the Eastern Churches. Though the feast was introduced in the west, its character lost there as the feast of Baptism of Christ, and associated with the manifestation of Christ to gentiles only.

The most characteristic feature of the Orthodox day of Epiphany is the sanctifying of waters by invoking the spirit that appeared in the form of a dove over Christ at the time of His baptism. The members received sanctified water at the end of the special service of ‘denhao’ which can preserve it for the entire year partaking of it at times of illness and other personal or family adversities.

With the month of January, another New Year begins for us. The name January comes from the Roman God Janus, the God with two faces, one looking forward and the other looking backward. This is indeed a time to look back at the year that has just ended and to look forward to the New Year ahead for us. “But this one thing I do; forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead” (Philippians 3:13).

Mar Milithios, accompanied by many cars was greeted at the entrance of our Cathedral by our Vicar, Managing Committee Members, Malankara Association Members, Delhi Diocesan Assembly Members, Youth Movement members, Marth Mariam Samajam members and Sunday School Teachers and Students from All over U.A.E. along with a large number of our Parish Members. Rev. Dr. Markose Joseph accompanied His Beatitude from Kerala.

We accorded a warm welcome to Very Rev. M.S. Skariah Ramban, our former Vicar, on 25th October 2006 on his arrival to Abu Dhabi .

A Grand Reception meeting was held on 26th October to felicitate His Beatitude and to commemorate the consecration of the newly built Parish complex. H.E. Ezziddin Ibrahim, the Cultural Advisor the President of U.A.E, H.E. Chandra Mohan Bandari, the Indian Ambassador to U.A.E. Very Rev. M.S. Skariah Ramban, The Delhi Diocesan Secretary, and many other distinguished guests were present during the meeting.

Thanks to the benevolency of the rulers of Abu Dhabi , a piece of land adjacent to our Church has been allotted to our Church. During H.H. Bava Thirumeni's visit, on 30th December 2006, the Holy Father visited and blessed the land and laid a foundation stone for construction of the boundary wall. We express our whole hearted thanks and gratitude to the rulers of Abu Dhabi for their kind gesture and allotting the piece of land free of cost for our Cathedral. After allotting the present Church plot, this is the first time a new piece of land is allotting to us and is considered as a historic event for us. We further express our thanks to all who worked for this purpose.
